# EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY PLAN

## (EPR PLAN)

That E-Waste Management Rule, 2016 was notified by the Government of India. In Section 3 (v) of the E-waste Management Rule 2016 provides provision of Extended Producer Responsibility Plan.

That we, the applicant i.e. **M/S RICHA INFOSYSTEMS PVT. LTD.** (further referred to as **PRODUCER** in this EPR Plan), as per Rule, hoping to deal in **ITEW 2, ITEW 3, ITEW 4, ITEW 9 and CEEW 1 in future.**

That in the Rule it has been described that every producer at the time of Applying for Extended Producer Responsibility Authorization, shall provide details of E-Waste Collection Scheme after end of product's life, channelization system for Targeted Collection. Details of authorized recycler with toll free number, Details of Reverse Logistics partner with whom the Authorized Recycler has agreement with, Estimated budget for implementing EPR plan and the scheme for creating awareness regarding E-waste. That all the above mentioned points are elaborated in details below.

## 1. GENERAL SCHEME OF COLLECTION

That the collection of E-waste after the end of Life and dismantling/recycling of the E-Waste is an important aspect of the rule. We understand the same and hence, for collection and dismantling/recycling of the E-waste, we have a complete plan for fulfilling of the target. The details of General Scheme of collection of E-Waste is given below.

Firstly, we entered into an agreement with dismantler/recycler named Deshwal Waste Management Pvt. Limited(hereafter Termed as DESHWAL) having its registered office (and recycling unit) at Plot No. 292, Sector-7, IMT Manesar, Gurugram, India and its Corporate office at SCO-82, 83, First Floor, Main Market, Sector-17 A, HUDA Market, Gurgaon-122001, Haryana, India. That total capacity of DESHWAL recycling plant as permitted by the HSPCB is 1800 MT. The Validity of HSPCB NOC is from 12/07/2018 to 11/07/2023. Also, we further assure that the recycler is fully competent for the recycling of electronic goods we deal in.

The toll free number which will be used by the customer to reach nearest collection points of their area is of the **Recycler i.e. M/s Deshwal Waste Management Pvt. Limited**

**TOLL FREE NUMBER of the recycler is 1800-102-9077**

That the recycler i.e. DESHWAL will provide the mechanism for the collection of E-Waste after end of life through their reverse logistic partner i.e. Reliable Trans Logistics. And DESHWAL has agreement with Reliable Trans Logistics and will use the warehouse of Reverse Logistic Partners as collection points. The photo copy of the Agreement will be attached with the application.

The customer can reach DESHWAL by dialing the toll free number 1800-102-9077. for disposing of their product after the end of life. Once DESHWAL representatives receives the call, they will explain the customer about the complete disposal of E-Waste. The representative will also make them aware about the nearest collection point where the product can be deposited. And the representative will inform them about the incentive scheme against their end of life product. Once, the material has reached the various collection points then it will be transported to M/s Deshwal Waste Management Pvt. Ltd. Recycling unit at their premises – at Plot No. 292, Sector-7, IMT Manesar, Gurugram, India for recycling purposes through DESHWAL's Reverse



Logistic Partner. That the details of collection on Pan India basis and the collection points including address has been mentioned as Annexure 1.

In this, the first nine addresses are collection Points of DESHWAL (i.e. Sl. No. 1 to 9) and the remaining addresses (from Sl.No. 10 to 27) are warehouses of reverse logistics partner of DESHWAL which will be used as collection points of DESHWAL.



That the collection points for collection of E-waste after end of Life for Sikkim and North-Eastern states i.e. Assam, Tripura, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, and Arunachal Pradesh will be Guwahati, Assam. The customers of these north eastern states can directly send their E-Waste to the collection points situated in Guwahati or call on 1800-102-9077, the Toll free number for any kind of information for the collection. Also, people from Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh shall send their E-Waste to the collection points Present in Delhi.

That it is clear from the above details that the recycler has collection Points in around 18 states and arrangements for the collection of E-waste for all states across India.

Same is more than the collection target prescribed in the E-waste Rule, 2016.

## **COLLECTION SCHEME**

That, well-known methods for the Collection of E-Waste are **BUY-BACK, EXCHANGE** and **DEPOSIT REFUND SCHEME (DRS)**. We will adopt all measures for recollection of E-Waste as prescribed in the Rule from time to time. That the all collection scheme will be implemented by the Recycler i.e. DESHWAL with the help of their Reverse logistics partnered. **Reliable Trans Logistics.**

### **BUY BACK**

Under buy back scheme, we will launch the schemes from time to time for the customers on the website. Also,

- We will propose to have a mechanism of incentivizing customer who wish to return their end of life product (E-Waste), whereby if any customer wish to discard their product, they can call on the Toll Free Number **1800-102-9077**. The representatives will explain them about the process of disposal and shall make aware them about nearest collection point available to drop the E-Waste or if required Schedule a Pick up request. And shall also give information about the incentives or exchange offer, if any, we will offer to them, against their end of life product.
- The discount coupon issued, if any, shall be redeemed by the customer at later stages.

### **EXCHANGE SCHEME**

We will run E-Waste exchange program whereby we will encourage our end user to deposit any of their Electronic product and they can exchange the same with either new one after giving some reasonable discount. This can be done at any of our collection point or by calling at Toll free number.

#### **DEPOSIT REFUND SCHEME**

Deposit refund scheme has not been opted, although we encourage our end users (customers) to handover their end of life product by giving them incentives. **In future, if possible, we can implement this scheme for collection of E-Waste.**

#### **DETAILS OF INCENTIVE SCHEME FOR RETURNING OF E-WASTE BY CONSUMERS /BULK CONSUMERS**

To keep high and persist the momentum of consumer for disposal of E-WASTE through proper system and further appreciate the initiatives of Consumer / Bulk Consumer to ensure environmentally sound management of E-WASTE, the producer will provide a reasonable discount on MRP as an incentive whereby respective customer shall get a discount against purchase.

**The Producer** on confirmation from E-WASTE recycler towards collection of E-WASTE from a particular customer, shall deliver the appreciation letter in the form of email to customer with company incentive offer.



## 2. CHANNELIZATION PLAN

The channelization of the E-waste/EOL (END OF LIFE) products is most important for implementation of E-Waste Rule, 2016. Without proper channelization plan, the extended producer responsibility cannot be completed. Hence, we have adopted an effective plan for the same so that our customer can easily reach to the collection points and return/deposit their E-Waste after end of life or whenever they want to send back for recycling purpose.

The channelization plan is given below.

- i. We entered into an agreement with DESHWAL for recycling of the E-Waste and the Recycler i.e. DESHWAL through its logistic partner will do the collection of the E-Waste (generated by the Producer/Bulk Consumer/Customer) from time to time.
- ii. That the collection of E-Waste is not possible until and unless the reverse mechanism has not been provided. For this purpose we got an assurance from the DESHWAL that they will collect the E-Waste throughout India.
- iii. That a copy of agreement has been provided by the recycler, which mentions their terms and conditions with their reverse logistics Partner i.e. Reliable Trans Logistic. That the logistic company has collection points at about 27 places across the country. And mechanism for collection of E-Waste will be on pan India basis.
- iv. That the people of Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh can send their E-Waste to Delhi. They can also call on toll free number of the recycler where the DESHWAL's representatives can guide them or Schedule a pick up request for their E-waste.
- v. Similarly, the collection points for collection of E-waste after end of Life for Sikkim and North-Eastern states i.e. Assam, Tripura, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, and Arunachal Pradesh will be Guwahati, Assam. The customers of these north eastern states can directly send to the collection points situated in Guwahati or call on **1800-102-9077**, the Toll free number of the Recycler for any kind of information for the collection.

Also, a Table has been provided on the next page which gives details about the collection points present in their respective states.

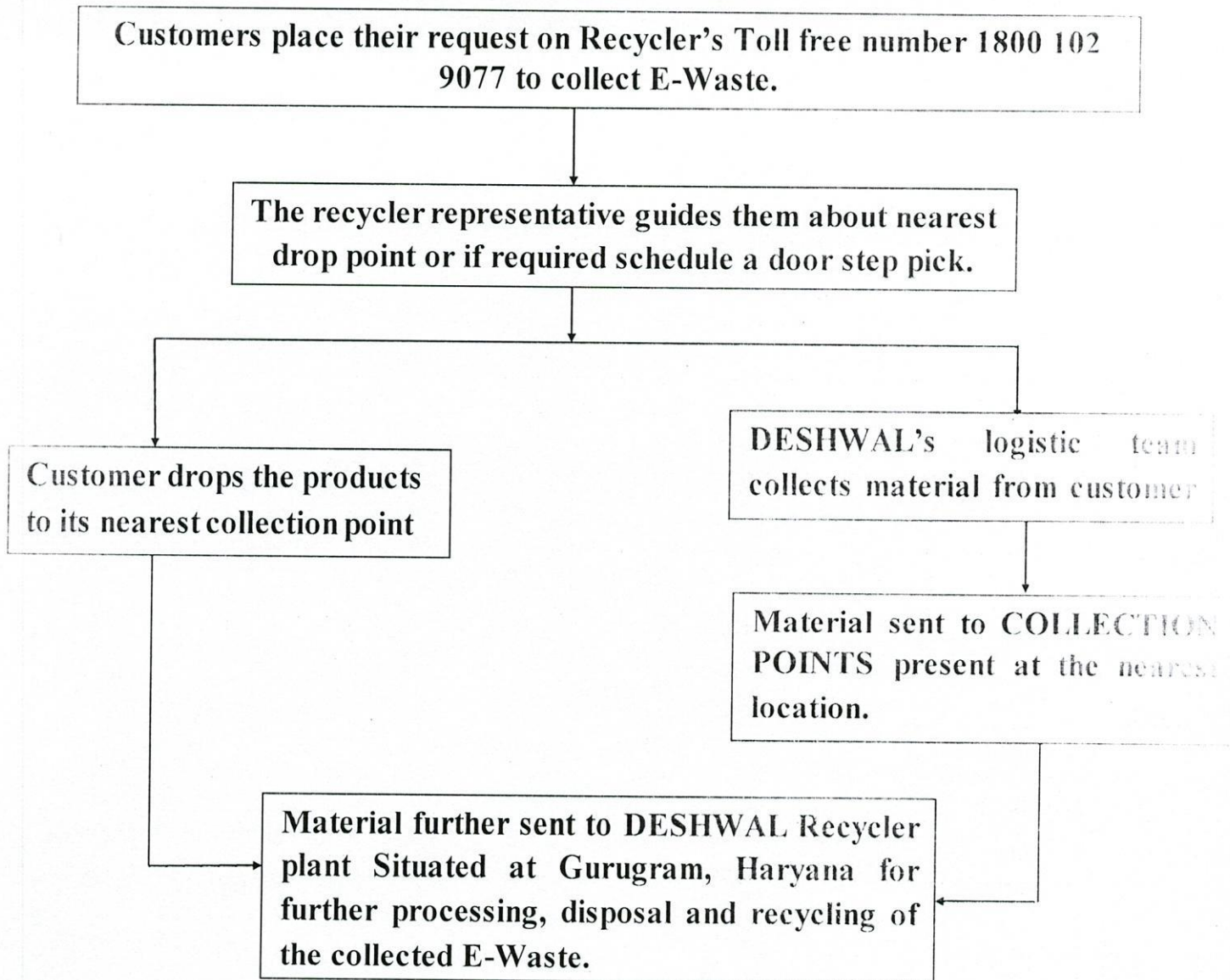

### Process of collection, storage & recycling

The **Producer** has tied-up with Govt. authorized E-WASTE recycler namely DESHWAL for facilitating the customers on PAN India Basis to collect E-WASTE product of the company from any location within India for further storage & recycling. For this purpose, Customer shall follow the following process:

- Customers place their request on **DESHWAL Toll free number 1800-102-9077** to collect E-Waste.
- The Company (DESHWAL) representative shall place the above request to their nearest collection points (from Customer designated location) as mentioned above.
- DESHWAL shall arrange to collect the E-WASTE from the Customer designated location through its transporter/Reverse Logistic Partner i.e. Reliable Trans Logistics, within the scheduled time.
- After collection from specified location, DESHWAL shall store the E-WASTE at its COLLECTION POINTS, and after that the collected E-WASTE shall be sent for dismantle at its main plant through a proper process & system using DESHWAL's Logistic Partner.
- After dismantling, DESHWAL shall provide the certificate of Recycling & destruction to the Customer for their record, if desired.

That it is important to mention that we have complete plan for the collection of E-waste on pan India basis. Hence, as per E-waste Rule 2016, the Extended Producer Responsibility Plan completely comply.
